



## Questions and Answers For Thought

**Question 1.** Who determines which teams are selected to participate in the KOHL'S – WWSA American Cup Tournament?

**Answer:** The American Cup Tournament is for club champions. Recreational Clubs will establish a process for determining which team shall be declared the champion. While most will use a season record or a play off system, this decision is up to the local clubs. Please consult with your local club officers to best understand how the selection process is run in your area.

**Question 2.** How does the league, association, or recreational club determine Eligibility for play in the Junior or Senior brackets of U-10 Mixed or U-12 mixed?

**Answer:** Go through the following thought process. Does the team have Any travel players (or recently rostered travel players) on it?  
If no.... you are eligible to play in either the Junior or Senior Bracket. You must declare this on your application.  
If yes.....continue How many players are listed on the roster? Note this as A.  
How many players are in the upper half of the 2 year age bracket.  
Note this as B.  
Divide B into A? or on a calculator B/A. Note the result.  
If the above result is less than 40%.....you are eligible to play in the Junior or Senior bracket. You must declare this on your application. If the above answer is greater than 40%..... you may only play in the Senior Bracket. You must note this on your application.

**Question 3.** May a league, association, or recreational club send more than 1 team per bracket to the Kohl's American Cup Tournament?

**Answer:** Each recreational league, association, or recreational club can enter up to 2 teams per division for Boys/Mixed teams and up to 4 teams per division for Girls teams. A club can send two teams to participate in each bracket. For the Under 10 and Under 12 brackets, this means a club can send up to 4 teams. Two teams will need to be registered as Junior teams while the other two teams will need to be senior teams. In the event that a champion for a bracket can not be determined, please contact the state office to discuss options for participation.
