WV Governor Justice has issued an Executive Order concerning sports. This was issued sometime last evening.

The order is very clear that the order includes soccer.

Therefore, effective immediately NO WVSA Sanctioned Soccer Activities may take place in WV, Any soccer activities, indoor or outdoor that are held in WV are without WVSA Sanction, Medical and Liability Insurance. WVSA ODP Scheduled for this Saturday is to be rescheduled.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE, pursuant to the authority vested in me pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 15, Article 5, Section 6 and Chapter 15, Article 5, Section 1 of the Code of West Virginia, hereby DECLARE and ORDER, effective immediately, that all sports teams and leagues, whether school-sanctioned or otherwise, including without limitation football, soccer, baseball, volleyball, basketball, swimming, wrestling, and cheerleading, are prohibited from bringing players and/or spectators together into a common area within this state for any team practice until, at the earliest, February 14, 2021, and are prohibited from bringing players and/or spectators together into a common area within this state for any competition until, at the earliest, March 3, 2021; provided, however, that team sports may safely continue to be conducted by accredited higher education institutions within this state. The provisions of this Order supersede any conflicting provisions of Executive Order 9-20, as amended, Executive Order 43-20, Executive Order 70-20, and Executive Order 80-20, as the same may be amended from time to time, only with respect to the subject matter hereof.
