Re: WWSA AGM and RTP

On 5/14/2021 WV Governor Justice stated he was lifting the mask mandate for persons who are FULLY VACINATED for COVID 19 as of today.

WWSA RTP Policy Update: Masks are not required by WWSA for Fully Vaccinated Persons. Persons not fully vaccinated must need to continue to follow all WWSA RTP Policies.

Fully vaccinated is two weeks after the 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna or 2 weeks after a shot of Johnson and Johnson. Our venue will be making the change that fully vaccinated people do not have to wear a mask. All others are expected to have a mask on unless active on the field of play

Mask should be worn while entering and exiting the soccer venue.

Mask should be worn by spectators when not social distancing while watching a game or practice.

All players, coaches, administrators and referees not actively involved in a game or practice should socially distance and wear a mask.

All other WWSA RTP policies remain in effect.

WWSA member clubs may have more restrictive polices and all WWSA members must follow policies of all venues.

WWSA will continue to monitor information and policy updates from the Governor's Office. And will keep everyone updated. All participants must complete the WWSA Screening Tool on paper or online for each event. All policies of events and venues, Local and County Health Department policies must be followed.
