WVSA Phase 3 continues until 6/25/20 - Please review the Phase 3 policies. Please adhere to all policies and guidelines to minimize the opportunity to spread COVID-19.

WVSA Phase 4 is scheduled to start on 6/26. Guidance will be updated and sent to all clubs and members following Tuesdays, 6/23/2020, WVSA BOD meeting. Anyone not normally part of the BOD / Staff / RTP calls should contact kristi@wvsoccer.net for the call information

Most restrictions and requirements from Phase 2 remain in effect for Phase 3 except the 10-foot distance between players on the field and the type of activity that may be a part of team training. WVSA would like to thank everyone for following WVSA Return to Play Polices and ask you to continue to follow the plan!!

- 1. If the facility you are using allows spectators to be out of their cars, <u>PLEASE</u> remind them that they must practice social distancing between non-family groups. Also, they must not be in areas around where teams are gathering before and after training.
- 2. Spectators and those waiting for the next training session must not congregate around the entrances, restrooms and other common areas.
- 3. Social distancing of 6 feet when off the field, including traveling to and from the parking lot and at all times off the field.
- 4. Coaches and all club personnel are required to wear face masks during all activities.
- 5. No team huddles or groups closer than the 6ft social distancing at any time.
