WWSA continues to work with USYS, other state associations and the WV Governor's Office to provide guidance to WWSA members as the fall season gets underway. We are sending out a Game day Guide that combines WWSA Policies and some suggested Best Practices in a format for parents, players, coaches and clubs. We hope that this will be useful for everyone. Please be sure to follow all State of WV, your local Health Department and WWSA Policies as you Return to Play. The only way we have to attempt to keep our players on the fields are to follow the guidelines. Call or email dave@wvsoccer.net with any questions.

WWSA has reached out to the Governors Office for clarification on the affect that the new color code system will have on non-school sports. As soon as we receive a response, we will send out the information. Several clubs have reported that local health departments have stated they intend to follow these guidelines for all non-school sports. Clubs should check with their local health departments to learn of their requirements. WWSA Clubs please notify kristi@wvsoccer.net of any restrictions imposed by your local health departments.

All WWSA Clubs are reminded to enforce social distancing and the wearing of masks per WWSA Policies. WWSA Clubs and events are able to make exceptions per the Gov order for those who can\ not wear a mask. The WWSA policy does not apply to parents or spectators but the wearing of masks is highly recommended. In the Memo Club Members refers to Club staff, BOD etc.
