WVSA continues to work with USYS, other state associations and the WV Governor's Office to provide guidance to WVSA members as the fall season gets underway. Please be sure to follow all State of WV, your local Health Department and WVSA Policies as you Return to Play. The only way we can keep our players on the fields are to follow the guidelines. The WVSA Board of Directors has tabled any decision on WVSA adopting the WV Color Code System until the next meeting on 9/8. WVSA has reached out to the Governor's Office for clarification on the affect that the new color code system will have on non-school sports. As soon as we receive a response, we will send out the information. Several clubs have reported that local health departments have stated they intend to follow these guidelines for all nonschool sports. Clubs should check with their local health departments to learn of their requirements. WVSA Clubs please notify kristi@wvsoccer.net of any restrictions imposed by your local health departments.

All WVSA Clubs are reminded to enforce social distancing and the wearing of masks per WVSA Policies. WVSA Clubs and events are able to make exceptions per the Gov order for those who can\not wear a mask.

The WVSA policy does not apply to parents or spectators but the wearing of masks is highly recommended. In the Memo Club Members refers to Club staff, BOD etc.
