Re: WVSA RTP Memo # 16 for clubs

Today the Governor and State Health Officials reported that on visits to various activities around the state there were many people not wearing Masks. Please be sure to enforce the WVSA Masks Policies for Players and Coaches and strongly recommend that All Spectators wear a mask!!!

As of today, WVSA members are permitted to train and play. This may change at any time!! PLEASE continue to support and enforce the WVSA Return to Play Policies!!! There have been several reports of exposure to COVID among players and coaches. WVSA clubs have reacted quickly and under the direction of their local health departments. So far, knock wood, there have been no reported cases of spread within the soccer family. Keep up the good work and lets keep our members on the field!!!!

WVSA continues to work with USYS, other state associations and the WV Governor's Office to provide guidance to WVSA members as the fall season gets underway. Please be sure to follow all State of WV, your local Health Department and WVSA Policies as you Return to Play. The WVSA Board of Directors has tabled any decision on WVSA adopting the WV Color Code System until the State of WV issues guidance. WVSA has reached out to the Governors Office for clarification on the affect that the new color code system will have on non-school sports. As of today, the Governor has not issued an order for non-school events. The State of WV will send Health Officials to inspect events that are being held. Take every precaution to be sure we can keep playing. Several clubs have reported that local health departments have stated they intend to follow these guidelines for all non-school sports. Clubs should check with their local health departments to learn of their requirements. WVSA Clubs please notify kristi@wvsoccer.net of any restrictions imposed by your local health departments.

All WVSA Clubs are reminded to enforce social distancing and the wearing of masks per WVSA Policies. WVSA Clubs and events are able to make exceptions per the Gov order for those who can\not wear a mask.

The WVSA policy does not apply to parents or spectators but the wearing of masks is highly recommended. In the Memo Club Members refers to Club staff, BOD etc.
