- 1. Introduction:
  - a. Announce Case
  - b. Introduce Chair, panel, Parties, witnesses, others.
  - c. Inquire about any conflicts or objections to panel members. i. Note and or resolve conflicts.
  - d. Review procedures to be followed, USSF By Law 701, WVSA Chpt 4 order of hearing.
  - e. Inquire about any objections or questions concerning rules and procedures to be followed.
    - i. Note and/ or resolve objections and questions.
- 2. Evidence
  - a. Introduce evidence as submitted
  - b. Ask for any additional evidence, if allowed.
  - c. Inquire about any objections or questions concerning evidence.
    - i. Note and/ or resolve any objections or questions concerning evidence.
- 3. Case Presentation
  - a. Case presented, including review of evidence and witnesses
- 4. Defense Presentation
  - a. Defense presented, including review of witness and evidence.
- 5. Questions from Panel
  - a. Members may ask questions of parties and or recall witnesses.
- 6. Closing Statements
  - a. Allow each party the same amount of time.
- 7. Review how and when decision will be announced/ distributed.
- 8. Adjourn Hearing
  - a. All except the hearing panel excused.
- 9. Deliberations
  - a. Use only evidence from the hearing.
  - b. Issue decision
  - c. Explain Appeal Process
    - i. Contact WVSA by email with appeal request within 5 Business days of the receipt of decision. Fee is \$100. Contact <u>Kristi@wvsoccwr.net</u> and <u>dave@wvsoccer.net</u>
    - j. Include, decision and grounds for appeal.
