Non Residents wanting to Play on a team In West Virginia

1. Contact the state soccer office where you live and complete the state player team status form requesting permission to play in West Virginia and pay any applicable fees to your resident state.

Until the permission to play in another state (PTSF) is completed and approved by both your resident state and WVSA, your child cannot be placed on a team in WVSA.

NOTE: A copy of the approval from your state office MUST be forwarded to me before I can release your child to play in WVSA. Some states email the form directly to me others send it to the parents. If you receive a copy with just your states approval on the bottom, please forward it to me at beth@wvsoccer.net so I can release your child in our registration system to play in WVSA.
